RECEPTION/SHOP HOURS

PEAK PERIOD—9:00AM - 5:00PM (Mon - Sun) OFF PEAK PERIOD-9:00AM-4:00PM (Mon - Sun) We have a convenience store located in reception. We also sell fuel, ice, coffee, bait and firewood. Closed on Christmas Day.

AMENITIES

Are open 24 hours for your convenience. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Please consider others and leave the amenities neat and tidy.

RUBBISH

All rubbish is to be placed in the big bins provided, by the pool area and on the boat parking hill.

SPEED LIMITS

All roads in the park are shared between pedestrians and vehicles. Speed limits are at walking pace (5kms/h).

BBQ AREAS

Please enjoy the free BBQ's at the camp kitchen and by the pool. Please consider others and leave the areas clean and tidy.

BICYCLES AND SCOOTERS

These are allowed to be ridden during daylight hours only and guests should observe road rules including the use of helmets.

GOLF CARTS

Conditionally registered golf carts are permitted in the park, however, must only be operated by persons holding a current C class licence and can only be driven in daylight hours.

WILDLIFE

As a guest you are welcome to enjoy the opportunities to interact with our local wildlife. As cute as they may be, feeding may be detrimental to their health, so don't feed the wildlife. Also be aware that some critters are not so cute. If you see a snake, stay away! AED

BOOM GATES

Please use your boom gate card or code for entry and exit into the park. Do not tailgate another vehicle. Boom gate codes are for the use of patrons only. Any visitor to the park must present to the office and receive a visitor day pass with their own boom gate code.

COIN CHANGE

Is available from reception for washing machines and dryers. They take \$1 coins and need \$4 per load. The reception only accepts cash for the coins.

DUMP POINT

See park map for the location. Please do not dump waste matter into toilets at amenities.

FIRES/FIRE PITS

Fires are permitted within non fire ban times. All fires are to be lit in the fire pits available for use. ALL FIRES PITS ARE USED AT RISK. Please do not light fires on the road.

PARKING

Please ensure when parking that no road or thoroughfare is blocked. If you require additional parking space then parking is available on the grassed hill indicated on the map. There is NO PARKING OF **BOATS ON ROADWAYS.**

PETS

Our park is pet friendly, however, to ensure a safe and hygienic environment for all guests, dogs MUST BE kept on a lead and owners MUST pick up after them. Pets are NOT allowed in any of the accommo- WATER HAZARD dation. Please let reception know if you have a pet with you.

QUIET TIME

Please be respectful of the enjoyment of others within the park by reducing noise levels at 10pm and NO MUSIC after 12am.

In the event of an emergency, we now have a defibrillator located at reception

BOATS

Boats are not to be moored at any beach. Boats must give way to swimmers.. Idol speed is 5mph.

BOAT WASH

Is available near the storage sheds for a token of \$5 for 10minutes. Tokens are available at the office during business hours. As the water is on a timer it is suggested that you flush your motor first to prevent any harm to the engine when the water cuts out.

WHEELCHAIR ACCESS

Is available in the southern end amenities.

TENNIS COURT

The court is free to use however, a charge applies for night use. Racquets and balls are available at the office and in the camp kitchen.

SWIMMING POOL

There is a swimming pool available for your enjoyment. Please note there is no lifeguard on duty. All children under the age of 12 must be supervised by an adult at all times. No glass is to be taken into the pool area. The pool is open between 9am-6pm. As per the current PHO, the pool is available to guests who are fully vaccinated at this time.

WATER

The park is serviced by river water. Drinking water tanks are located at each amenity. Bottled water is also sold at the office.
